At Örebro stadsarkiv, digital archive databases are available in our reading room. You can access scanned church records from the 1600s - 1900's, military rolls, and other archival documents from all of Sweden.

The databases on the computers enable you to search for emigrants and immigrants from the entire county of Örebro covering the period 1840-1930, as well as emigrants from all of Sweden. The estate inventory registers and other databases and CD-based information are also available as sources for research.

The Emigrant Index Files sometimes includes appendices like letters, photographs, biographies, addresses to descendants in the USA, etc.

Örebro stadsarkiv gratefully accept material contributions to the Emigrant Index Files. We copy and scan letters, photographs and other material referring to the emigrants from our county. Maybe you have something of interest for the archives?

Örebro stadsarkiv has original municipal documents from the municipality of Örebro dating from early 19th century until now. We also possess a unique photo archive, including between 500.000 - 1 million photographs from the 1860's until present time. More than 50.000 photographs are available in a database on our website.
